"This is our showstopper," says Mike Mack, product manager for Venom. "We've studied the market and looked at all of the other side patios out there to come up with a version that offers the best of the best and has three or four features that nobody has."

Venom features a standard four TVs – including one on a swing arm that can be removed and taken outside to be mounted on the coach in a bracket that is located on the wall along with cable and satellite hookups. The coach also includes an outside refrigerator, so RVers don't have to go far for a beverage while watching that outdoor TV.

The coach has four entries with two doors: one side patio entry and an entry on the rear patio.

Dual sofas, a bath-and-a half and a kitchen with an 18-cubicfoot refrigerator or optional residential refrigerator offer plenty of comfort. Kitchen amenities include large functional countertop surfaces and large cabinet storage space as well as a stainless-steel appliance package with a 30-inch residential microwave.

The 13-foot garage will hold most toys on the market.

Other features include the MyRV control system that uses a smart device App to control the awnings, landing gear, HVAC system and generator, as well as other systems.

An optional off-grid package includes 160 watts of solar panels and a 1,000-watt inverter.

"The dealers love it because they can put this package on the unit, throw a battery in it and the battery will stay charged and they can show the coach fully featured at any time without having to run power to it," Mack says.

MSRP for the Venom 4113 is approximately \$99,000.

What impressed RVPRO: The Venom 4113 could be considered the tailgater's toy hauler. Four TVs means if there's any disagreement over what pregame show or game to watch, everyone will have an option. Also, four side entries mean everybody doesn't have to squeeze by the crowd to get in and out of the coach. But for the true toy hauler enthusiast, the 13-foot garage means getting even the biggest vehicles out to the desert will be no problem. Venom is versatile enough to handle whatever challenge is thrown at it.
